Service Projects

An important component of the Confirmation Process is Service Projects. St. Bernard's requires the completion of 30 hours of service, 20 of which are completed in the Church and 10 in the community.

Examples of service within the Church setting include: Altar serving, youth choir, church sponsored activities such as the "Giving Tree", helping at Generations of Faith or other special parish events, and assisting with tasks in the Parish Center.

Community Service could include: raking a neighbor's yard, baby sitting (free of charge), volunteering with Special Olympics, etc.

All service projects should be documented on a Service Project form by the STUDENT. He/she is responsible for tracking and documenting the hours. They should be turned into the Parish Center as they are completed.

There are many opportunities for students to develop their own projects for a cause that may be important to them. How about a fundraiser for a special cause? Or a special project to beautify the Church grounds. Think about your gifts and talents. How does God want you to use them?
